



## **Prepare USB memory device for device update**

The updater files can be unpacked by using WinZip or any “unzip” utility that creates the original folder or any Windows OS that allows you to double click on the .zip file and see the contents (folder) inside of the .zip file.

### **How to Copy the required Updater files to a USB Memory Device**

After unpacking the .zip file, copy the complete folder inside the .zip directory to the root of the USB memory device. The USB memory device will then be inserted into the FDC devices USB port which will allow you to update the FDC device.

#### **\* What are “zip” files?**

*If you are not familiar “.zip” files, it is a utility for file compression, encryption and to combine multiple files and directories into a single compressed file. Windows 7 allows users to copy files and directories contained in a “.zip” file to another location while XP will require 3<sup>rd</sup> party software to first unzip the zip file. With Windows 7, highlight the zip file on the left side of Windows Explorer to show the content on the right side. With the zip file contents shown on the right side highlight the desired files to copy to the root directory of the USB Memory Device.*

*Regardless of operating system, 3<sup>rd</sup> party software is typically required to create or unzip a “zip” file.*
